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Consolidated Appropriations Act Section 204 Data Collection (RxDC) - June 2026 Submission

Section 204 of the Consolidated Appropriations Act (CAA) of 2021 and its implementing regulations require health insurance issuers and group health plans to report to the United States Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, the Treasury (the "Departments") and the Office of Personnel Management certain information regarding prescription drugs and health care spending (also referred to as RxDC reporting).

UPMC Health Plan will submit the data on behalf of its fully insured and self-funded employer group clients in compliance with this year's deadline and subsequent time frames as communicated by the Departments. Submissions will include all employer groups active with UPMC Health Plan during any portion of each submission period, including groups that are no longer active with UPMC Health Plan.
